Name as the Lone Star Conference 1st Team as well a Defensive Back of the Year.

As a Sophomore in 2008 ... Appeared in 11 games last season ... Recorded 63 tackles, as well as breaking up nine passes and blocking a kick ... Made two interceptions, one against Angelo State (Oct. 4, 2008) and another against Texas A&M Kingsville (Oct. 11, 2008), which he returned for five yards before being brought down ... Earned ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District 6 Honors and was named the the Lone Star Conference South Division Honor Roll ... Selected the the ENMUSports.com Football Player of the Week on October 26th

As a Freshman in 2007 ... Played in 11 games for ENMU ... A strong force against the opposition's passing game, Tillman broke up five passes in 2008, in addition to recording 53 tackles, two for a loss of yardage ... Intercepted a pass on Sept. 15, 2008 against East Central, after which he gained 13 yards before being brought down

Before ENMU ... Played four years at Baytown Sterling High School under Coach Herb Minyard ... A multi-sport athlete, Tillman also lettered in basketball and track ... Achieved all district recognition for his play as a cornerback twice ... State qualifier in the 400 meter event in track ... Awarded All-State Academic Team his senior year

Eric Czerniewski, Central Missouri Offensive Player of the Year



Central Missouri's **Eric Czerniewski** topped NCAA Division II with 5,207 passing yards and 46 TD passes while leading the Mules to an 11-3 mark and a national quarterfinal appearance. The senior quarterback set new MIAA career marks with 12,874 passing yards and became the league's total offense leader. He threw for 300 yards 10 times in 2010.

Larry Dean, Valdosta State Defensive Player of the Year



Valdosta State's **Larry Dean** led the Blazers to an NCAA Division II postseason appearance tallying 122 tackles in 11 games while becoming the Gulf South Conference's career tackles record holder. Dean eclipsed the old GSC mark by 25 tackles while besting the Valdosta State career mark of 340 previous held by Jessie Tuggle.

Tillman Stevens Caps Stellar Career as Daktronics First Team All-American

PORTALES, N.M. — Senior defensive back Tillman Stevens (Baytown, Texas/Sterling HS) from the Eastern New Mexico University football team has been selected First Team Daktronics All-American, for his outstanding efforts on the field during the 2010 season. Stevens was one of four Lone Star Conference players to earn Daktronics First Team All-America status.

The selection marks the second consecutive year in which a Greyhound defensive back has been selected All-American. Last year, Rodney Mitchell (Sr., CB, Sarasota, Fla./Palmetto HS/NMMI) made Don Hansen's Football Gazette All-American First Team and Daktronics Second team.

The award caps a season, which saw Stevens earn First Team Daktronics All-Super Region 4, LSC North Division Defensive Back of the Year and First Team All-LSC North. Stevens also was selected as a D2Football.com Defensive Player of the Week and LSC North Defensive Player of the Week for a three-interception, ten-tackle performance against University of Central Oklahoma. With his selection, he will advance to the national ballot, with a chance at making All-American.

Stevens led the Lone Star Conference and finished tied for seventh in the nation, with 11.1 tackles per game. He also tied for the conference lead and 11th in the country with six interceptions, including one, which he returned 62 yards for a score against Central Oklahoma.

He registered a career-high three interceptions along with ten tackles and two passes broken up. In the fourth quarter, he sealed the game by returning an interception 62 yards for a score. For the game, Stevens registered 81 yards on interception returns. Stevens has intercepted five passes in the last two games. Of his 122 tackles, he made 61 solo stops and seven tackles for a loss. In a win over Southeastern Oklahoma State, Stevens blocked a point-after-touchdown attempt, giving him a blocked kick for the third consecutive season.

His four-season career with the Greyhounds spanned 44 games, with 283 total tackles, 156 unassisted stops and 12 interceptions with 186 return yards. He also has registered two sacks, both coming this season.
